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Directions

From Roseville to SNA

1. Merge onto **I-80 E** toward RENO.
2. Take **Exit 123** for **Bell Rd.**
3. Turn **LEFT** onto **Bell Rd.**
4. Turn **RIGHT** onto **CA-49N**
5. Turn **LEFT** onto **Dry Creek Rd.**
6. Turn **LEFT** onto **Richardson Dr.**
7. Parkside Church on the right, turn in and follow to the back to SNA

From Placerville to SNA

1. Follow **CA-49 N/Coloma Rd/Golden Chain Highway N**
2. Turn **LEFT** onto **CA-193 W/CA-49 N/ El Dorado St.**
3. Turn **RIGHT** on **Elm Ave.**
4. Merge onto **I-80 E** via the ramp to Reno
5. Take **Exit 123** for **Bell Rd.**
6. Turn **LEFT** onto **Bell Rd.**
7. Turn **RIGHT** onto **CA-49N**
8. Turn **LEFT** onto **Dry Creek Rd.**
9. Turn **LEFT** onto **Richardson Dr.**
10. Parkside Church on the right, turn in and follow to the back to SNA

From SNA to Gold Hollow Campground

1. Turn **LEFT** onto **Richardson Dr.** toward Dry Creek Rd.
2. Turn **RIGHT** onto **Dry Creek Rd.**
3. Turn **LEFT** onto **CA-49 N/Golden Chain Highway N/Grass Valley Hwy**
4. Follow thru Grass Valley and Nevada City, (appx. 23 mi from SNA)
5. Turn **LEFT** onto **CA-49 N**, toward Sierra City/Downieville (appx .3mi)
7. Turn **RIGHT** onto **N BLOOMFIELD RD** (appx. .5mi)
8. Turn **LEFT** onto **LAKE VERA PURDON RD.** (appx. 2mi)
9. Follow to **Gold Hollow Campground, 17183 LAKE VERA PURDON RD**, on the right!

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
